



Dominion Transmission Crayne Station



Featured in the September/October '05 issue of *Distributed Energy* magazine, Dominion Transmission is the largest natural gas storage and transmission company on the East Coast, and a significant user of distributed energy systems.

Dominion's Crayne Station in southwest Pennsylvania uses three Capstone C60-ICHPs to ensure power security and to warm decompressed gas.

Several other Dominion Transmission facilities use Capstone MicroTurbines, including one in central New York that helped keep natural gas fuel flowing to other stand-alone Capstone MicroTurbines operating in the region during the massive Northeastern Blackout of 2003.
