

Eastern Municipal Water District



The Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) of Southern California uses eight Capstone C60 microturbines to create cooling (via a York absorption chiller), heating and power on its large campus half way between Los Angeles and San Diego.

The microturbines were provided to the EMWD by the South Coast Air Quality Management District. The SCAQMD has purchased more than 150 Capstone MicroTurbines, including a CHP array of four C60s for their Diamond Bar headquarters, to support distributed energy projects that help the authority reduce NOx emissions in the Southland.
